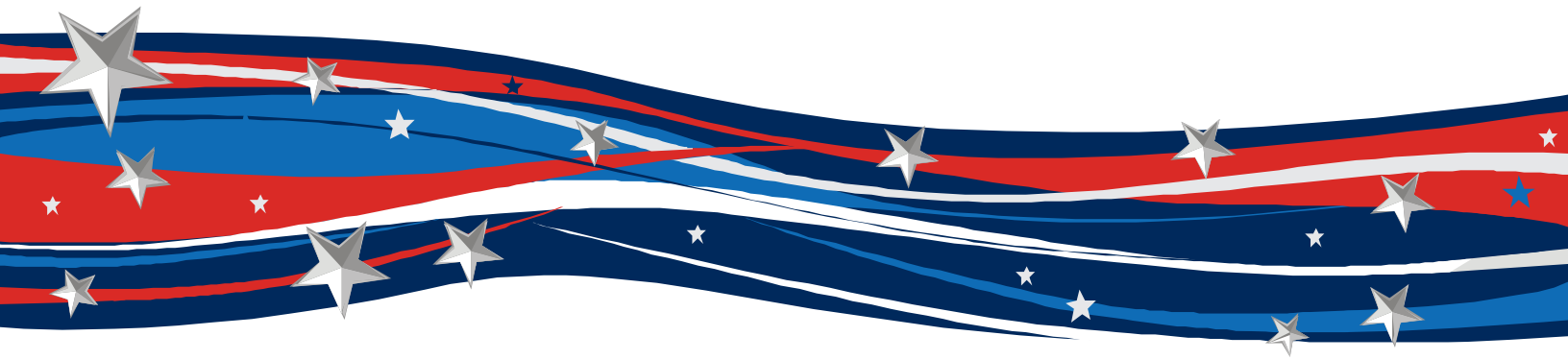

The number of employment-related claims and lawsuits arising from Equal Opportunity Commission (EEOC) charges continue to increase. Examine new laws and current trends that will impact future litigation and the types of claims made against employers. Learn how these changes impact the exposures your clients face.

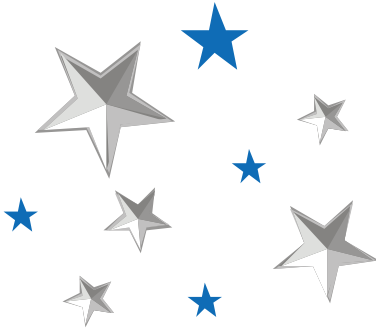
